PROVINCIAL MANAGEMENT SERVICE (PMS) AND ASSISTANT EXCISE AND TAXATION OFFICER (AETOs) COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION, 2025

In the quarter under report, the Commission conducted written competitive examination for 55 posts of PMS in Establishment Department and 22 posts of AETOs in Excise and Taxation Department from 20.11.2025 to 04.12.2025.

Screening test for the aforementioned posts was held on 16th July, 2025 for 27921 candidates who had either applied for the posts of PMS or AETOs or both, wherein 9896 candidates achieved the 50 % threshold thereby qualified for competitive examination. To facilitate the candidates at their nearest station, total 61 exam halls; 47 Male and 14 Female were reserved in all seven (7) Divisional Headquarters of the Province, wherein 5071 candidates (51%) appeared in the exam.

The Commission extends its gratitude to the Provincial Govt. for its sponsorship and facilitation ensuring timely conduct of the exam. The Commission also extends appreciations to the District Administration for their optimal security arrangements and facilitation. The cooperation of the colleges, schools and other institutions ensuring smooth conduct of the exam is highly appreciated.

COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION FOR THE POST OF PROVINCIAL PLANNING SERVICE (PPS)

The Commission conducted competitive examination for 59 posts (Adv. 3/2025 and 6/2025) of Provincial Planning Service (BS-17) in Planning and Development Department from 16th December, 2025 to 18th December, 2025 in double sessions. Total candidates applied were 7887 (after excluding common candidates) whereas 1507 (19%) appeared in the exam.

RE-ARRANGING OF ABILITY TESTS FOR CANDIDATES OF DISTRICT KURRAM ONLY

The Commission arranged five (5) Ability Tests of Male/ Female Lecturer Chemistry, English and Physics on 24th and 25th October, 2025 at KP PSC Halls. On the direction of Peshawar High Court, the Commission re-arranged Ability Tests for candidates of District Kurram as they could not appear in the above tests held in November, 2024 due to deteriorating law and order situation. Consequently, all the pending results of such ability tests have been announced.

RECRUITMENTS FINALIZED

The Commission finalized the recruitment process for the following posts by disposing off 38930 applications wherein 1627 candidates were interviewed. 252 candidates were recommended to the Govt. for appointment while 628 posts remained unfilled due to non-availability of eligible/suitable candidates. RECOMMENDATION OF DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE (DSP)

The recruitment process for forty two (42) posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP BS- 17) in Police Department was completed in the quarter. Twenty (20) candidates who qualified written exam were interviewed from 1st October, 2025 to 2nd October, 2025 wherein 11 candidates were recommended to the Govt. for appointment while 31 posts remained unfilled.

RECOMMENDATION OF CIVIL JUDGES CUM JUDICIAL MAGISTRATE IN PESHAWAR HIGH COURT

The Commission also finalized the requisition of Civil Judges cum Judicial Magistrate/ Alaqa Qazi (BS-18) in Peshawar High Court. Total 47 candidates qualified the written exam, for which Psychological Assessment Test was held on 23rd October, 2025. Final interview was conducted from 8th December, 2025 to 12th December, 2025. Finally, 12 candidates were declared qualified and recommended to the Govt. for appointment while 100 posts remained unfilled and will be re-advertised in due course.

PHYSICAL TEST FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT SUB INSPECTOR (EXECUTIVE CADRTE)

The Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Public Service Commission conducted Physical Test for the post of ASI in Police Department from 01.10.2025 to 28.11.2025 at Qayyum Sports Complex and at Hayatabad Sports Complex. Due to unavailability of sport grounds, the said Physical Test will be resumed from 07.01.2025 for the remaining candidates. The required physical standard is as follows:-

FOR MALE:	Height: 5 feet and 7 inches Chest: 33 x 34 ^{1/2} inches Running: 1600 meters in 8 minutes
FOR FEMALE:	Height: 5 feet and 1 inch Chest: Exempted Running: 1000 meters in 8 minutes
