The Hon'ble Governor expressed his appreciation for the Commission tireless efforts in ensuring the selection of the most suitable candidates for various positions, thereby enhancing the administrative efficiency of the Govt. machinery. He also assured the Commission of his unflinching support and patronage, reaffirming his commitment to the Commission's mission and objectives.

COMPETITIVE EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED

A. PMS IN-SERVICE

The Commission conducted competitive examination for 36 posts of Provincial Management Service (In-Service Quota) from 9th April, 2025 to 10th April, 2025. Total candidates were 465, however, during scrutiny 268 candidates were found eligible while 177 (66%) eligible candidates appeared in the examination.

B. CIVIL JUDGES CUM JUDICIAL MAGISTRATE

The Commission conducted competitive exam for the 112 posts of Civil Judges-cum-Judicial Magistrate (BS-18) in Peshawar High Court from 15th April, 2025 to 18th April, 2025 at Peshawar city. Total 2101 including 510 female candidates applied against 112 posts while 825 (39%) candidates appeared in the written part of competitive examination whereby 6600 answer scripts are in evaluation process with the examiners.

C. DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE (DSP)

A Competitive examination was arranged for 42 posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Fast Track Promotion Quota) in Police Department from 22nd April, 2025 to 25th April, 2025. Total candidates were 202 out of which 75 candidates were found eligible while 69 appeared in the exam.

The Commission announced the result of DSP (FTP) on 25th June, 2025 in a short span of 2 months. Thirteen (13) candidates qualified the written part of exam while the result of thirteen (13) candidates were kept pending till the final decision of Hon'ble Peshawar High Court.

D. SUB INSPECTOR

The Commission also conducted another competitive exam for the post of Sub Inspector (Fast Track Promotion) in Police Department against 479 posts from 20th May, to 23th May, 2025. In all 486 candidates applied and after scrutiny, 117 candidates were found eligible while 104 appeared in the examination.

E. ASSISTANT SUB INSPECTOR

The Commission also conducted the 5th competitive examination in the quarter for Assistant Sub Inspector (Fast Track Promotion Quota) in Police Department from 29th May, to 31st May, 2025. Total candidates were 6395 wherein 3532 (55%) candidates appeared in the competitive examination.

ABILITY TEST HELD DURING THE QUARTER

The Commission conducted 18 Ability Tests for 16336 candidates against 153 posts in various Provincial Govt. departments, during the quarter. Details as follows:-

RECRUITMENTS FINALIZED

During the Quarter under report, the Commission disposed-off 17994 applications of candidates for 145 posts. Recommendations of 137 successful candidates were conveyed to the government for appointment while 8 posts remained unfilled due to non-availability of eligible/suitable candidates. POSTPONEMENT OF ABILITY TESTS

The Public Service Commission conducted ability tests for the post of Lecturer in English (Male), Lecturer in Chemistry (Male & Female), and Lecturer in Physics (Male) in November 2024. Due to the prevailing law and order situation in Kurram District, the tests for the candidates of that district were postponed and rescheduled in May 2025 as a relief measure. However, in compliance with a recent order from the Peshawar High Court, the exams have been postponed once again due to law and order situation.

As a result, thousands of candidates are eagerly waiting for their results, which are contingent upon the completion of the examination process for the remaining candidates of the mentioned district.

RECRUITMENT PROCESS FOR LECTURER POSTS RESUMED

The Higher Education Department of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa initially requested the Commission to halt the recruitment process for Lecturer posts in various subjects/ disciplines. Subsequently, the Department approached the Commission to resume the process for the following subjects on three separate occasions:-

1. On August 6, 2024, six (6) subjects; Botany, Chemistry, English, Physics, Urdu, and Computer Science
2. On October 1, 2025, Islamiyat/ Islamic Studies
3. On April 22, 2025, seven (7) more subjects: Economics, History, Health & Physical Education, Mathematics, Statistics, Pakistan Studies and Political Science.

The remaining subjects i.e. Geography, Pashto, Home Economics, Psychology and Zoology will be resumed depending upon the request of HED.

RESULT OF WRITTEN PART OF PPS EXAM

The Commission announced the written result for the posts of Provincial Planning Service (PPS) on 22nd May, 2025 in Planning & Development Department. The exam held in December, 2024 for 7236 candidates, out of which 1375 candidates appeared while 18 (1.3%) candidates qualified the written exam. In the competition, the paper of English Essay proved a litmus test for the candidates where 150 out of 1362 (10.9%) candidates passed the paper. Other statistics of the result are given below:-
